



Scholarship Conditions of Entry

- 1 The applicant must :
 - be under 18 years of age at the date of audition and a resident of Orange region
 - be already undertaking instrumental or vocal lessons
 - have reached AMEB/TRINITY level grades 4 - 8 or equivalent
 - be willing to improve his/her skills by undertaking tuition with the best available tutor as selected in consultation with the auditioning panel
 - undertake that any awarded funds will be designated towards his/her music education or music instrument
- 2 The panel will take into consideration the stage of tuition, age and musical potential of the applicant
- 3 If vocal or instrumental lessons are recommended by the adjudicators, the proceeds of the scholarship will be paid to the tutor on receipt, by the Trust, of periodic invoices.
- 4 If the funds are directed to music education requirements (eg sheet music, workshops, instrument purchase or repairs) the successful applicant must provide receipts of purchase to the Trust.
- 5 All applications must be postmarked on or before the closing date.
- 6 **CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATIONS IS 15 AUGUST OF EACH YEAR**
- 7 No late applications will be accepted.
- 8 The successful applicant will abide by the decision of the auditioning panel.
- 9 The scholarship will not commence until the scholarship agreement is signed.
